Please submit your completed application to the Chair of the Department of Biology by **Friday, March 11, 2011**.

Quantity: two per year

Value: \$500 each (amount can vary from year to year)

Conditions: Available to full-time national and international M.Sc. and Ph.D. students working within the fields of conservation or environmental studies in vertebrate biology. The criteria for the award will include a high academic standing in graduate and 4th year courses in the area of research undertaken (minimum grade acceptable 80%) and the appropriateness of the field of study. Consideration will also be given to the research progress made by the candidate, as included by his/her advisory committee. Preference will be given to candidates who do not hold any other major award. Applications should include a letter of intent, transcript and supervisor progress letter.

The winning candidates must be willing to make a presentation to the Sudbury Game and Fish Protective Association.

This scholarship is administered by the Department of Biology and the candidates are chosen by a selection committee comprised of members of the Department of Biology.

Applications should be submitted to the Chair of the Department of Biology and should include a letter of intent, CV, transcript(s), a reference letter from the supervisor.
