**Value:** \$2,180 (amount can vary from year to year)

**Conditions:** Available to full-time M.Sc. and Ph.D. students involved in research in aquatic ecology that has relevance to Whitson Lake, with emphasis on fish habitat ecology and restoration in the Greater Sudbury Area. The criteria for the award includes a high academic standing in graduate and possibly 4<sup>th</sup> year courses in the area of research undertaken, the appropriateness of the field of study and the research progress made by the candidate, as indicated by his/her advisory committee.

This scholarship is administered by the Department of Biology and goes to a qualified Canadian candidate chosen by a selection committee comprised of members of the Department of Biology and representatives from Fisheries and Oceans Canada.
