Marita I. Mallory Cancer Research Bursary

The Bursary (\$1,000) will be awarded each year to a full-time graduate student working within the field of cancer research or related oncological studies. The criteria for the award will include a high academic standing in graduate and 4th year courses (minimum grade acceptable 80%) and the appropriateness of the field of study. Consideration will also be given to the research progress made by the candidate, as outlined by his/her research advisor. Preference will be given to candidates who do not hold other major awards. Applications should include a letter of intent, resume, official transcript(s), a letter of recommendation from the research advisor and expected budget of expenses. The decision will be made by a "selection committee" appointed by the Department of Biology.
