

Application to the Master of Science in Nursing

Thank you for your interest in Laurentian University's Master of Science in Nursing (MScN) program. To complete the on-line application, please review the following process.

1. The application is available at <http://horizon.ouac.on.ca/laurentian/grad/e>. Please note that the MScN program offers two options of study, a Thesis stream and an Advanced Practice stream. For MScN applicants who are certificated Primary Health Care Nurse Practitioners, the usual stream of study is Advanced Practice.
2. Confidential Referees Appraisal Form is to be completed by three professionals familiar with your work. At least one academic reference is preferred. Forms are included with the on-line application. A completed appraisal is forwarded by the appraiser to the Admission Department whose address is outlined on the form.
3. An application essay addressing reason(s) for pursuing an MScN degree, learning objectives, area(s) of clinical and/or research interest(s) as well as expectations of the program. The written submission is an important aspect of assessing eligibility for the program. This essay must be typed and not exceed four pages of double-spaced, 12-point font print.
4. One official transcript of all university programs and courses completed. An official document is original or notarized.
5. A current copy of the applicant's College of Nurses of Ontario Registration or equivalent.
6. Authorization and Direction to Research Information Form prepared by Admissions.

For International students, applicants must fulfill the admission criteria established by the university's proof of language proficiency.
