Privileges

The following privileges are awarded to professor emeritus/a, librarian emeritus/a.

The same privileges as awarded to our retired full-time faculty members, per Article 2.50.3 of the Collective Agreement:

- a) The right to their title and the listing of their name and their title in a special section at the back of the University Calendar, until the death of the member.
- b) The same library privileges as full-time members, parking facilities as per full-time members, and such other University facilities as may be granted by the Vice-President, Academic at his/her discretion.
- c) The same exemption from tuition fees for themselves, their spouses, and their dependents as full-time members, as per Article 4.53.
- d) The same eligibility for free Physical Education Centre membership for themselves, their spouses and their dependants as full-time faculty members, as per Article 4.56.

PLUS the following additional privileges:

1. The right to their title and the listing of their name and their title in the University Calendar under the department/school listing, until the death of the member.
2. The formal awarding of their certificate and a high rank in academic processions.
3. Identification card with photograph.
4. Eligible to participate in competitions for research dollars as per Article 2.7.
5. Eligible for thesis supervision at the discretion of the Unit and Graduate Studies.
6. That their publications be included within the Bibliography of Faculty Publications and Research.
7. Access to mainframe computing facilities by modem as for regular members.
8. Free parking upon request by the professor emeritus/a, librarian emeritus/a.
9. Free business cards upon request by the professor emeritus/a, librarian emeritus/a.
