The following criteria will be considered:

- Individual exhibits outstanding professional and personal achievement, commitment to the Huntington University community, and exemplary service to his/her community.
- Individual demonstrates the ability to initiate and execute by creating or developing a program or project that impacts the community at large.
- Individual recognized within the community for his/her pursuit, courage, enthusiasm, and passion.
- Individual displays the highest standard of community leadership, dedication, ability and innovation.
- Individual has three years of marked contribution to Huntington University.

Nomination packages must be completed in full; and include the following.

- A nomination form.
- A complete dossier that includes appropriate supporting documentation.
- Three supporting letters (other than the nominator).
