# THE EDWARD J. CONROY AWARD FOR EXCELLENCE IN TEACHING

As the current Chancellor of Huntington University, Dr. Edward Conroy continues a distinguished career in law and serves as the proud ceremonial head of our institution. In recognition of exceptional teaching performance, Huntington University has established the inaugural *The Edward J. Conroy Award for Excellence in Teaching*. Any faculty member within the Huntington University community may be nominated by their colleagues or by student members for outstanding contributions to teaching.

The following criteria will be considered:

- The individual's ability to stimulate and motivate student knowledge and dedication.
- The individual's use of effective communication.
- The individual's involvement and accessibility in and outside the classroom.
- The individual's effectiveness in encouraging student participation.
- The individual's ability to work collaboratively with colleagues.
- The individual's ability to demonstrate compassion and concern for the well-being of students and colleagues.
- The individual's involvement in professional growth activities.
- The individual must have taught during the 2009-2010 academic year.
- The individual must have contributed a minimum of three years service to teaching.

Nomination packages must be completed in full; and include the following.

- A nomination form.
- A complete dossier that includes appropriate supporting documentation.
- Three supporting letters (other than the nominator) from a student, faculty/colleague and other.
