

## GRADUATE STUDENTS

### MARITA I. MALLORY CANCER RESEARCH BURSARY

The Marita I. Mallory Cancer Research Bursary will be awarded to M.Sc. and Ph.D. students engaged in cancer and related oncological research. Applicants must be full-time students registered in one of the Laurentian University graduate programs.

Please submit your completed application to the Chair of the Department of Biology by **Friday, February 4, 2011.**

**Quantity:** One per year

**Value:** \$823 (amount can vary from year to year)

**Conditions:** Available to full-time M.Sc. and Ph.D. students working within the field of cancer research or related oncological studies. The criteria for the award will include a high academic standing in graduate and 4<sup>th</sup> year courses (minimum grade acceptable 80%) and the appropriateness of the field of study. Consideration will also be given to the research progress made by the candidate, as outlined by his/her research advisor. Preference will be given to candidates who do not hold other major awards. Students must be an **Ontario resident\*** as defined by OSAP and demonstrate financial need.

\*Ontario Resident is defined as a student who has resided in Ontario for at least 12 months prior to start of program.

This bursary is administered by the Department of Biology and the candidate is chosen by a selection committee comprised of members of the Department of Biology.

*Applications must be submitted to the Chair of the Department of Biology and should include a letter of intent, CV, transcript(s), a reference letter from the supervisor and a completed Financial Needs Application Form for Bursaries.*
