

ISM Research Associate – Contract Position

Subject to budgetary approval, the Institute for Sport Marketing (ISM) in the Faculty of Management at Laurentian University is seeking a Research Associate for a 4-month, full-time position with the possibility of extension. The position will report to the Director of the ISM and will be dedicated to supporting the publication in peer-reviewed journals of the data resulting from the various ISM research projects. Salary is negotiable and will be commensurate with qualifications and experience.

The ideal candidate will possess a graduate level degree that included a successfully-defended thesis (PhD, M.Sc., MA, MBA). They will have strong writing, research and analysis skills, as well as experience in publishing in peer-reviewed management journals. The position is located in Sudbury and the successful candidate will work out of the ISM headquarters in a collaborative and vibrant research environment.

The ISM is in a period of growth and development. An officially recognized research centre of Laurentian University, the ISM is coming off arguably the most successful year in its 7 year history. It is home to two SSHRC grants, an international research division, and research projects with a variety of external organizations including the Canadian Cancer Society, Gatorade, the City of Elliot Lake, the Director of Food Services, the Canadian Sponsorship Forum, and the Ottawa Senators.
