Quantity: One per year

Value: \$3,822 (value can vary from year to year)

Conditions: Available to full-time M.Sc. and Ph.D. students involved in research in aquatic ecology that has relevance to Whitson Lake, with emphasis on fish habitat ecology and restoration in the Greater Sudbury Area. The criteria for the award includes a high academic standing in graduate and possibly 4th year courses in the area of research undertaken, the appropriateness of the field of study and the research progress made by the candidate, as indicated by his/her advisory committee. Students must be an **Ontario resident*** as defined by OSAP and demonstrate financial need.

*Ontario Resident is defined as a student who has resided in Ontario for at least 12 months prior to start of program.

This bursary is administered by the Department of Biology and the candidate is chosen by a selection committee comprised of members of the Department of Biology and representatives from Fisheries and Oceans Canada.

Applications must be submitted to the Chair of the Department of Biology and should include a letter of intent, CV, transcript(s), a reference letter from the supervisor and a completed Financial Needs Application Form for Bursaries.
