Access awards: Effective for the 2010-11 academic year, Laurentian University will offer new applicants \$5,000 over four years (\$500 in first year of study at LU, \$1,000 in second year of study at LU, \$1,500 in third year of study at LU, and \$2,000 in fourth year of study at LU). Four new awards are part of the 50th anniversary program.

Eligibility: All qualifying new secondary school applicants and mature applicants who register in a four year full-time undergraduate program on the Sudbury campus. Secondary school candidates must have a minimum 70% on the top six marks from Grade 12 or level 4 U/M courses, regardless of prerequisites for the intended program of study. Applicants will be able to continue to receive the access awards if they remain in a 4 year program on the Sudbury campus and maintain at least a 70% average in the previous year on a full time (minimum 24 credits) course load. If an applicant fails to renew, he or she remains ineligible for the access awards for the duration of their studies at Laurentian. International applicants as well as applicants who qualify for a tuition exemption do not qualify for these access awards. Applicants can only qualify for one of the four access awards. Only applicants from outside of the City of Greater Sudbury and the Census District of Sudbury¹ are eligible for the access awards. All applicants remain eligible for other grants and scholarships offered by Laurentian.

Descriptions and Eligibility

1. *Northeastern Ontario and Simcoe-Muskoka Access Award:*

Applicants residing in Northeastern Ontario (outside the city of Greater Sudbury and the census district of Sudbury¹) and Simcoe-Muskoka who register in a four year full-time undergraduate program on the Sudbury campus.

Renewal: In order to renew the access award, the applicant must maintain at least a 70% average in the previous year on a full time (minimum 24 credits) course load.

2. *Native Studies or Native Languages Access Award:*

Students who have successfully completed one Grade 9, 10, 11 or Grade 12 credit in Native Languages or Native Studies, or who have completed a course in Native Languages or Natives studies at a previous postsecondary institution, and who register in a four year full-time undergraduate program on the Sudbury campus.

Renewal of award: In order to renew the access award, the applicant must maintain at least a 70% average in the previous year on a full time (minimum 24 credits) course load.

Additional requirement: Applicants must provide a copy of their secondary school, or previous postsecondary institution transcript.

3. *French Immersion or Extended French Access Award:*

Students who have completed a Grade 12 French credit as well as a minimum of 3 other credits in another subject offered in the French language and who register in a four year full-time undergraduate program on the Sudbury campus.

Renewal of award: In order to renew the access award, the applicant must annually take and successfully complete at least 3 credits in any discipline offered in the French language and maintain at least a 70% average in the previous year on a full time (minimum 24 credits) course load.

Additional requirement: Applicants must provide a copy of their secondary school transcript.

4. *Francophone Students Access Award:*

Students who register into a four year full-time undergraduate program offered in French on the Sudbury campus and who enroll annually in a minimum of 18 credits offered in the French language.

Renewal of award: In order to renew the access award, the applicant must be enrolled in a program offered in French, take annually a minimum of 18 credits offered in French and maintain at least a 70% average in the previous year on a full time (minimum 24 credits) course load.
