***Broadcast Journalism and Production***

**COURSE DESCRIPTION:**

This course explores the structure and history of broadcasting, trends in technological development and current practice in reporting and writing for television. Using the assistance of professional journalists and broadcasters, this course will help students identify their interests/strengths in broadcasting and hone their skills in both its technical and journalistic aspects. The chief goal is to familiarize all participants with the dynamics of visual and audio communication, how it works and how they can work with it. (3 CR)
