

## ENROLMENT OPTIONS: FULL-TIME

Students will normally complete the degree in two years. A total of 30 credits is required.

### Course Stream (suggested pattern):

#### Year 1: Fall and Winter

- HUMA 5004: Seminar in Interdisciplinarity (non-credit)

#### Year 1: Fall

- HUMA 5116 (Core I) (3 cr)
- HUMA 5117 (Core II) (3 cr)
  - One elective (3 cr)

#### Year 1: Winter

- HUMA 5016: Practicum Development (3 cr)
  - Two electives (2 X 3cr)

#### Year 2: Fall and Winter

- HUMA 5105 (Practicum placement in fall; research paper in winter) (6 cr)
  - Seminar in Interdisciplinarity (non-credit)

#### Year 2: Fall

- One elective (3 cr)

#### Year 2: Winter

- One elective (3 cr)

NOTE: In the Course Stream, a total of five electives must be taken over the course of four semesters, i.e. one elective per semester plus one. This means that in one of the four semesters the student will take two electives.

- HUMA 5105 (Practicum: on-site work in fall; research paper in winter) (6 cr)
  - Seminar in Interdisciplinarity (non-credit)

\* **Note:** The thesis (HUMA 5024) is evaluated as a single unit worth 9 credits. It is shown as (3 + 6) credits for administrative purposes only.
