General **admission** requirements

- Completion of Levels 1-4 of the CGA program or equivalent
- Minimum two years work experience
- A recognized undergraduate degree or equivalent
- 70% or a B average in prior post-secondary and professional education

Applicants without an undergraduate degree will be considered for admission provided they have achieved significant work experience at an intermediate management level and have demonstrated a strong academic aptitude.

Completion of the CGA designation and/or presentation of a GMAT score are not required for admission, but will strengthen an application.
