The School of Social Work at Laurentian University is seeking a bilingual (English and French) candidate for a 3-year appointment. The position commences on August, 2013, or whenever it is filled with a qualified candidate.

The School provides an environment rich in cultural diversity with undergraduate and graduate programming provided in English and in French. The chosen candidate's workload will consist of 12 credits taught in English in the Baccalaureate Social Work (B.S.W.) program and 3 credits taught in French in the Baccalauréat en service social (B.S.S.) program.

The chosen candidate will have a PhD in social work, or equivalent, or a Master Degree in Social Work, and university teaching experience. The candidate will have experience in one or more of the following areas: direct practice, anti-discrimination, community organizing, and social policy.

In accordance with Canadian immigration requirements, priority will be given to Canadians and permanent residents.
