

School of Human Kinetics Exceptional Alumni Award

Each year¹, the School of Human Kinetics honors two of its alumni during the spring convocation. Members of the School of Human Kinetics, including faculty, staff, and alumni are invited to nominate appropriate candidates for the selection committee's consideration. The purpose of the award is to recognize the important contribution the alumni have made to the field of human kinetics or to his/her community.

Criteria for nomination;

1. Only individuals who have received an undergraduate or master's degree from Laurentian University's School of Human Kinetics are eligible.
2. Individuals must have made outstanding contributions in one or several of the following areas since their graduation in order to be considered;
 - a. Scholarly work
 - b. Teaching/Coaching
 - c. Athletic Achievement
 - d. Not-for-profit Organization
 - e. Community Building
 - f. Public Service
 - g. Private Enterprise

Selection Process

Four current full-time members of the School of Human Kinetics, the current president of the SHK Student Council, and one alumni of the School, in addition to the Director of the School, will be asked to be on the selection committee. Committee members will be asked to serve for a maximum term of three years. Faculty and staff members interested in being on the selection committee can provide their name to the school secretary during to the first school council meeting at the beginning of each academic year. In the event that more than four faculty or staff members are interested, the selection of the committee members will be determined by a majority vote. Nominations for the *SHK Exceptional Alumni Award* will be accepted until February 1 of the current academic year. Selection of the awardee(s) will be determined by a majority vote. The selection committee will bring forward up to two names to the March school council meeting. Where possible, the names should include one male alumnus and one female alumna. Once the alumni are selected, the School Director is responsible for contacting the individual in order to invite them to the presentation ceremony. The nominator is responsible for writing a biography that will be read during the ceremony. A nominee does not need to be present to receive the award. During the ceremony the alumnus will be invited, but not obligated, to address the graduates.

¹ The intent is to have 2 awardees per academic year; however this is contingent on the annual number of nominees.
