Biographical sketch: Graeme Mount, PhD (1939-) moved from Montreal to Sudbury in 1969. Since his arrival at Laurentian's Department of History, Mount has taught courses in Canadian, American and Latin American history. He has published several papers and books on topics relating to Canadian history, Canadian-American relations, Latin America, the Caribbean, and espionage.

Scope and Content: The Graeme Mount collection consists of copies of Consulate correspondence (originally 1910-1935) from the Department of State. The files pertain to the Ku Klux Klan, the closure of the Consular Agency in Sudbury, American Tourism via Sault Ste. Marie, World War I and Economic matters and prohibition in the 1920's.
