Biographical sketch: Charles P. Ferguson lived in Mindemoya and was Secretary-Treasurer for the Carnarvon Agricultural Society. Carnarvon was a Township on Manitoulin Island until it was amalgamated into the Township of Central Manitoulin in June 1998.

Scope and content: The fonds attests to the role of the Secretary-Treasurer of the Carnarvon Agricultural Society, and on the activities of the Society. Records of Charles Ferguson son's attendance at the Sunday School and information on his wife's family also informs us on his family. It consists of a minute book, a member roll book, correspondence, documentation. Are also included United Church Sunday Scholl roll, and information of F. Bond's Estate.
